# 2026 National Mounted Police Colloquium & Civilian Sensory Clinic

The KHP Mounted Police and the Lexington Mounted Police units host the annual National Mounted Police Colloquium at the Kentucky Horse Park, Monday, Sept. 7–Friday, Sept. 12. These clinics bring people and horses from all over the country to learn new techniques, share ideas, and train their horses. Training is always conducted in a controlled environment geared toward improving the confidence of both the horse and rider.

Held in conjunction with the Colloquium on Saturday, Sept. 13 & Sunday, Sept. 14, the Civilian Equine Sensory Training Clinics feature national and international instructors who provide obstacle, sensory, and equitation training for horse and rider.

With an estimated 200 police and another 60 civilians in attendance at the Colloquium, sponsorship is an excellent way of supporting these mounted police officers who protect and serve with their trusted equine companions.

From local officers, to major metro officers, to Border Patrol, and Canadian Mounted Police Officers, the National Mounted Police Colloquium is highly regarded as the nation's top training program, which is held annually at the Kentucky Horse Park.
